Free Will and the Grace of God: the Battle for Our Hearts

- 3. ...no one goes to the Father except by me. (John 14.6)

...Jesus said to those who believed in him, "If you obey my teaching, you are really my disciples; you will know the truth, and the truth will set you free."

John 8.32

Except by God's Grace We are All Enslaved to Sin

"We are the descendants of Abraham," they answered, "and we have never been anybody's slaves. What do you mean, then, by saying, 'You will be free'?" John 8.34

Except by God's Grace We are All Enslaved to Sin

Jesus said to them, "I am telling you the truth: everyone who sins is a slave of sin. A slave does not belong to a family permanently, but a son belongs there forever. If the Son sets you free, then you will be really free. John 8.34-36

The Battlefield for the Fight for Salvation is the Heart

Everything that belongs to the world —what the sinful self desires, what people see and want, and everything in this world that people are so proud of—none of this comes from the Father; it all comes from the world.

The world and everything in it that people desire is passing away; but those who do the will of God live forever.

1 John 2.15-17

How We Are Enslaved to Sin

- The 5 P's:
 - Physical well-being
 - Possessions
 - Pleasure
 - Power
 - Prestige
- When love / desire / lust for these comes first in our lives it results in enslavement to them.

The Desire to Cling to the Passions Blinds Us

This is the judgment, that the light has come into the world, and men loved the darkness rather than the light; for their works were evil. For everyone who does evil hates the light, and doesn't come to the light, lest his works would be exposed.

John 3.19-21

The Desire to Cling to the Passions Blinds Us

Why do you not understand what I say? It is because you cannot bear to hear my word. You are of your father the devil, and your will is to do your father's desires..

John 8.43

The Spiritually Blind are Unable to Come to Christ

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To Will to Be Freed is Necessary but Insufficient

...work out your salvation with fear and trembling. For it is God who works in you both to will and to work, for his good pleasure.

Philippians 2.12-13



Listen! I stand at the door and knock; if any hear my voice and open the door, I will come into their house and eat with them, and they will eat with me. To those who win the victory I will give the right to sit beside me on my throne, just as I have been victorious and now sit by my Father on his throne.

Rev. 3.20-21

[God's] divine power has granted to us all things that pertain to life and godliness, through the knowledge of him who called us by his own glory and virtue; by which he has granted to us his precious and exceedingly great promises; that through these you may become partakers of the divine nature, having escaped from the corruption that is in the world by lust.

St. Peter, 2 Peter 1.3-4

...walk by the Spirit, and you won't fulfill the lust of the flesh. Those who belong to Christ have crucified the flesh with its passions and lusts.

St. Paul, Galatians 5.16; 24

There is therefore now no condemnation to those who are in Christ Jesus, who don't walk according to the flesh, but according to the Spirit.

For what the law couldn't do, in that it was weak through the flesh, God did, sending his own Son in the likeness of sinful flesh and for sin, he condemned sin in the flesh;

that the ordinance of the law might be fulfilled in us, who walk not after the flesh, but after the Spirit.

St. Paul, Romans 8.1-4



...they have conquered him by the blood of the Lamb and by the word of their testimony, for they loved not their lives even unto death. Rev. 2.11

- 1. God is not willing that any should be lost.
- 2. Our hearts become attached to what we love.

- 3. Our hearts should be attached to God.
- 4. Because of the Fall of Adam and Eve, we tend to love ourselves more than God and our neighbor.

- 5. Self-love attaches our hearts to love / desire / lust for possessions, pleasure, power and prestige.
- 6. We can become enslaved to what our heart is attached to, even to the point of breaking the law of love of God and love of our neighbor.

- 7. The Church Fathers call the things we are enslaved to the "passions."
- 8. For some, enslavement to the love of possessions, pleasure, and prestige blinds them to their condition.

- 9. Others who recognize the problem and want to be freed discover that they are unable to do so—they are enslaved.
- 10.To "will" to be freed is necessary but insufficient.

- 11. To be freed takes the intervention of an outside power—God.
- 12. Being freed from the passions is a synergistic effort between God and man.
- 13. Christ became a man to have a human nature and as the Second Adam heal the fallen human nature.

- 14. The battle for the salvation of people takes place in their hearts.
- 15. These are the reasons why:
 - 1. No one can come to Jesus unless the Father draws/enables him/her.
 - 2. No one can go to the Father except through the Son.
